CARe would like the opportunity to showcase programs that are culturally relevant and specific.

We invite proposals for presenters or workshops that develop analysis or strategies for preventing sexual violence against women of under-served communities. Informational workshops/presentations, skills-building workshops, artistic presentations, and workshops using other creative formats are all welcome. We particularly welcome workshops/presentations that focus on strategies for building grassroots mobilization and community organizing rather than simply social service delivery.

Proposals should be no more than one page in length. **Proposals may be submitted electronically or sent via United States Postal Service. All proposals must be received by January 31st.** Please include a brief bio, resume and any other relevant information.
